Dear Secretary Bose:

The accompanying joint tariff is sent to you for filing in compliance with requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act ("ICA") and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission regulations. This tariff is issued by Explorer Pipeline Company ("Explorer") in connection with Marathon Pipe Line LLC ("Marathon") and bears the designation as F.E.R.C. No. 103.15.1. The tariff is filed to become effective September 16, 2017.

F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 103.15.1 amends F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 103.15.0 and contains the following revisions:

- Item No. 125, Routing was updated with corresponding tariff numbers; ~~and~~
- Table of Rates, Part I has been updated due to a clerical error in the rates for Route 1 and Route 4, Wood River destinations;
- Table of Rates, Part I Points of Origin for Port Arthur Jefferson County, Texas; Mont Belvieu, Chambers County, Texas; and Pasadena, Houston, Harris County, Texas were calculated incorrectly in FERC 103.15.0. The rates have been recalculated and corrected in FERC 103.15.1. Invoices for these rates have not gone out, so no refunds are due.

Explorer was granted market-based authority in Docket OR99-1-000, issued June 30, 1999 (87 FERC ¶ 61, 374). Explorer's local rates in connection with the joint tariff are market-based rates pursuant to 18 CFR § 342.4(b). Marathon's local rates were established under market-based rate making authority pursuant to the Commission's Order in Docket No. OR00-1-000, issued September 12, 2001. These joint tariff regular rates and specialty product rates to the Explorer and Marathon destinations listed above are less than or equal to the total rates of the filed local tariffs for Marathon and Explorer (participating carriers) as indicated in Marathon's F.E.R.C. No.'s 298.5.0, 301.6.0 (Docket No. IS17-317-000), and 303.8.0 (Docket No. IS17-253-000), and reissues thereof, and Explorer's FERC No. 100.68.0 (Docket IS17-557-001).


