Re: F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 101.15.0 (Docket No. IS19-94-000) cancels F.E.R.C. Tariff No. 101.14.0 (Docket No. IS18-645-000)

Dear Secretary Bose:

[N] This transmittal letter is sent to correct Transmittal Letter 361 which was incorrectly numbered and filed with FERC No. 101.15.0 by Explorer Pipeline in Docket No. IS19-94-000. All other information in the tariff and transmittal letter is unchanged.

The accompanying tariff is sent to you for filing in compliance with requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act ("ICA") and the Commission's regulations. This tariff is issued by Explorer Pipeline Company ("Explorer") and bears the designation as F.E.R.C. No. 101.15.0 which cancels F.E.R.C. 101.14.0. The tariff is filed to become effective January 1, 2019.

FERC No. 101.15.0 provides for volume incentive rates for regular products and specialty products to any Shipper deliveries from Phillips 66 Carrier LLC's ("Phillips 66") Hartford, Illinois Terminal to Explorer's Wood River origin facilities to Explorer's destinations at St. Louis, Missouri; East St. Louis, Illinois; Wood River, Illinois; Irwin/Cochin Terminal, Illinois; Marathon Griffith, Indiana; Hammond, Indiana, and Buckeye Chicago Complex, Indiana. Phillips 66 concurs with the filing of FERC No. 101.15.0.

FERC Tariff No 101.15.0 contains the following revisions:

- The Table of Contents was updated with correct page numbers;
- Item No. 5, Definitions was updated to be consistent with Explorer's FERC tariff 100.77.0 definitions;
- Item No. 10, Commodity & Specifications, Section (a) has been added to comply with the requirement of § 341.4;
- Item No. 20, Minimum Delivery at Destination, Section (a) has been revised to clarify that less than 5,000 barrels may be delivered at destinations if operational issues warrant it; and Section (c) has been updated to be consistent with Explorer's FERC tariff 100.77.0;
- Item No. 25, Notice of Intent to Ship; Binding Nominations; Payment Obligations; Shipping Schedules section numbering was updated to be consistent with Explorer's FERC tariff 100.77.0;

- Item No. 90, Proration of Pipeline Capacity, has been updated to reflect the July 1, 2018 Petroleum Products Proration Policy;
- Item No. 100, In Transit Storage, Tankage at Hammond, Indiana has been updated to correct a clerical error;
- Item No. 105, Transshipment and Delivery Tankage at Hammond, Indiana has been updated to correct a clerical error;
- Item No. 112, Volume Incentive Rates for Specialty Products to St. Louis, Missouri; E. St. Louis, Wood River, and Irwin/Cochin Terminal, Illinois; and Marathon Griffith, Hammond, and Buckeye Chicago Complex, Indiana has been updated to be consistent with Explorer's FERC 100.77.0;
- Item No. 125 Routing updates Phillips 66 Carrier LLC and Explorer Pipeline Company FERC tariff numbers; and
- Table of Rates, Parts I, II, III and IV reflect average rate increase of 1.85% depending on destination.

Explorer was granted market-based authority in Docket OR99-1-000, issued June 30, 1999 (87 FERC ¶ 61,374). Explorer's local rates in connection with the joint tariff are market-based rates pursuant to 18 CFR § 342.4(b). Phillips 66 local rate is initially justified on a negotiated rate pursuant to 18 CFR § 342.2(b). These joint tariff volume incentive rates and specialty product rates to the Explorer destinations listed above are less than or equal to the total local rates of the posted tariffs for Phillips 66 and Explorer (participating carriers) as indicated in Phillips 66 FERC No. 4.9.0, Docket No. IS19-090-000, and Explorer's F.E.R.C. No. 100.77.0, Docket No. IS19-76-000.


