The accompanying tariffs for Magellan Pipeline Company, L.P. ("MPL"), a subsidiary of ONEOK, Inc., issued November 27, 2024 to be effective January 1, 2025, are sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Interstate Commerce Act and the rules and regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission"). Said tariffs are issued by Jake Nolte, Manager, Liquids Pipelines Rates & Tariffs.

F.E.R.C. No. 166.33.0 canceling F.E.R.C. No. 166.32.0 IS24-459-000 F.E.R.C. No. 171.39.0 canceling F.E.R.C. No. 171.38.0 IS24-459-000

Explanation of Tariff Filing

As further explained below, this filing contains joint rates and incentive rates with Explorer Pipeline which have been increased. Throughout the tariffs, administrative edits are made to clarify language referencing other MPL tariffs.

F.E.R.C. No. 166.33.0 contains joint rates which have been increased. These increases synchronize with Explorer Pipeline's local tariff rate increases reflected in **F.E.R.C.** No. 100.126.0, filed November 22, 2024 to be effective January 1, 2025 (Docket No. IS25-99-000) under Explorer's market-based ratemaking authority, which was granted by the Commission in Docket No. OR99-1-000, issued June 30, 1999 (87 FERC ¶ 61,374).¹ All rates in **F.E.R.C.** No. 166.33.0 are below the corresponding base rates.

F.E.R.C. No. 171.39.0 contains incentive rates which have been increased. These increases synchronize with Explorer Pipeline's local tariff rate increases reflected in **F.E.R.C.** No. 100.126.0,

filed November 22, 2024 to be effective January 1, 2025 (Docket No. IS25-99-000). All rates in **F.E.R.C. No. 171.37.0** are below the corresponding base rates.

However, MPL respectfully requests that, should the Commission determine that any such waivers are required, the Commission grant such waivers as are necessary in order that the revised tariff records may be made effective as proposed.
